April 7, 1959

Coperion Corporation (then known as Werner & Pfleiderer Corporation) was established as a sales office in New York City.

During the early 1960's

The company relocated to northern New Jersey, opening an office, shop, and process lab in Waldwick, NJ.

In 1977

Manufacturing operations were started to better serve the NAFTA customer base. As the business developed the company purchased property and constructed a new facility in Ramsey, NJ.

In June 1980

The company moved into its new headquarters building and has remained there since. The facility included expanded manufacturing and assembly space, warehousing, and a sophisticated pilot plant and process demonstration laboratory.

In 2001

With the formation of Coperion, the company since has expanded to include a modern manufacturing facility in Wytheville, Virginia and a sales and project management office in Houston, Texas.
